- 2) New Academic Programmes Initiated (UG and PG):**

The College has introduced the Post Graduate Programme – M.A. in Economics from the Academic Year 2010-11 under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). This four semester PG programme is introduced under Autonomous System with 96 credits.

Two Add-on Programmes namely Advanced Diploma in Career Development and Communication Skills (Awarded UGC grants of Rs.5,00,000/- under the scheme of COP) and Diploma in Business Process Outsourcing (Awarded UGC grants of Rs.5,00,000/-

under the scheme of COP) are implemented during 2006-07 were successfully continued during 2010-11 also.

 - Response for the above courses is overwhelming as they are need-based.

3) Innovations in curricular design and transaction :

- The Autonomous system is introduced by the College from the academic year 2007-08.
- All the 16 Board of Studies (BOS) of the College have redesigned the syllabi for the first and second semester UG and PG programmes to cater to the needs of the employment market. This will enable us to attain not only excellence but also empower the pupils to take up career of their choice. The syllabus is framed in consultation with the experts from the industry and academic fields.

- The redesigned syllabus is taught through innovative teaching methods like LCD, Digital Boards, Internet, latest CDs, interactions with professionals and practitioners, panel discussions, lectures with experts, project report writing, practice lesson plan, dissertation, field survey reports, role play newspaper/magazine/journal clippings, lectures by subject experts, industrialists implant training along with the conventional lecture method.
- The Titles of different papers for all the semesters have been altered by Board of Studies of respective subjects.
- Question Banks are supplied to give an exact idea of semester End examination Question Paper Pattern and marking system. Question Banks also help the students to plan and prepare well for the final Examination. The Question Banks are prepared according to the guidelines of UGC for Autonomous Colleges.
- The core reading/ text material is compiled in a book form and is given to students by the departments of Kannada and English for III and IV Semesters.
- Photo copy hand outs of reference material of the newly introduced subject are given to the students for reference, by the departments of English, Commerce and Economics.
- Compulsory in-plant training at the end of the second and fourth semesters for B. B. A. Programme. 50 Marks are awarded for the project report and 50 Marks for the viva – voce.
- Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) is introduced for PG programmes – M.A. in English and M.A. in Economics under Autonomous System. The student study 04 Compulsory Courses and 01 Optional Course, in all the four semesters. Besides these the students also study a Basic Course/Open Elective Course during first three semesters. Project Report Writing is mandatory for these programmes during fourth semester. These PG programmes
 - Enable the students to study open electives of their choice and interests.
 - Provide additional knowledge of the subject along with the core and specialization subjects.
 - Accord interdisciplinary approach to the formal study of the course.
 - To use theoretical knowledge for practical purposes.
 - To gain an insight into the subject of their choice & its area of application.

o Distribution of 30 Marks of Internal Assessment for B.B.A. is as follows:

- Three tests carrying 50 marks each of 90 minutes duration. Later the marks are reduced for 10. The best two test marks are considered for average. i.e 2 tests x 10 marks : 20 Marks
- The allotment of 10 marks is based on presentation by students, Case analysis, Quiz, Project report writing, assignments, role play, surprise test, objective type test etc. : 10 Marks

The weightage for all these parameters differs from one paper to another.

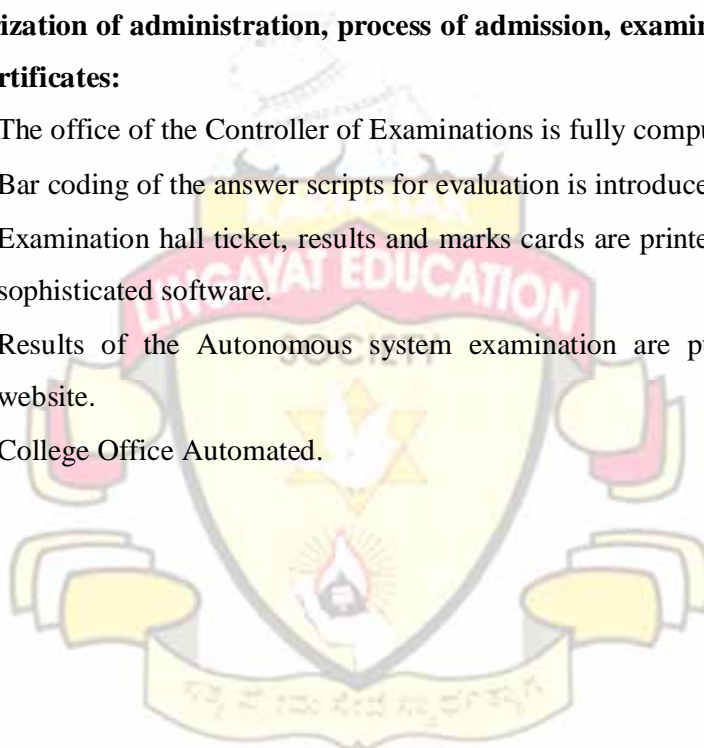

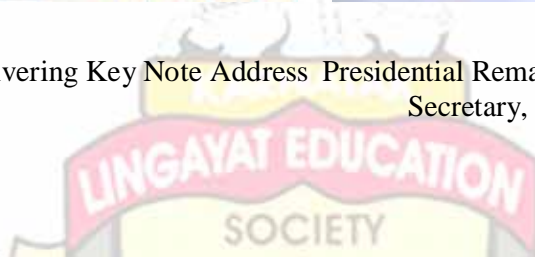

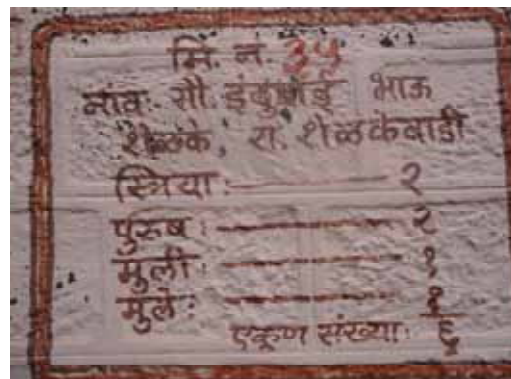
